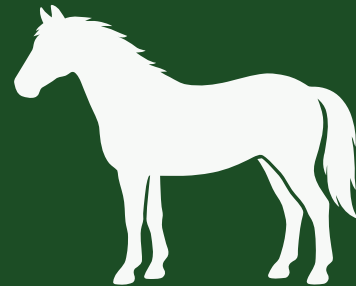

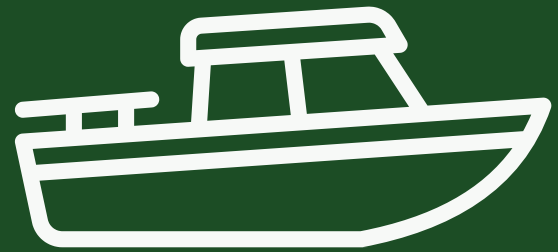

RAINBOW FALLS TOUR

This full-day adventure travels across Clearwater and Azure Lakes to Rainbow Falls, where guests can enjoy canoeing, swimming, rainforest hiking, wildlife viewing, and a picnic lunch on the beach. The tour operates from 10:30 AM to 5:00 PM.

TANDEM PARAGLIDING FLIGHT

Soar like a bird on a tandem flight with an experienced pilot. The experience includes transportation to the launch site, safety instruction, all required equipment, and approximately 15–30 minutes of flight time depending on weather conditions. Allow about 2 hours for the complete experience.

\$249.10 per person (tax included).

GOOD TO KNOW

Passengers must weigh between 27 kg (60 lbs) and 120 kg (260 lbs). Good footwear, long pants, and a warm jacket are recommended. Helmets are provided. Flights operate from spring through fall and are weather dependent.
