



Spring ITINERARY

DAY 1 - CHASE WATERFALLS

Spring is the perfect time to experience the waterfalls at their mightiest. Take a drive to see some of the park's most iconic waterfalls:

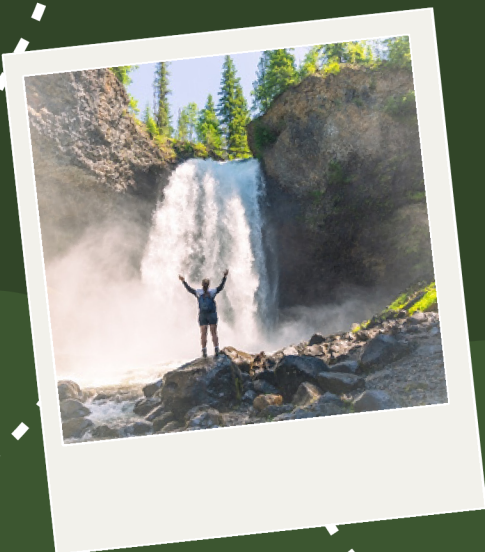
Spahats Falls → Dawson Falls → Helmcken Falls

Stretch your legs on the Grove of Giants Trail at Spahats Falls and immerse yourself in the park's unique ecosystem of ancient cedar and hemlock.



DAY 2 - WATERFALLS & WILDLIFE

Keep your eyes open for wildlife along the road into Wells Gray Park — spring is one of the best times for sightings. Stop at Triple Decker Falls for a quieter viewpoint, then hike to Moul Falls where you can hike down to the base of the waterfall - be prepared to get wet if you plan on trying to walk behind these two waterfalls in the Spring!



DAY 3 - EXPLORE CLEARWATER

Slow things down in Clearwater with a morning paddle on Dutch Lake (rentals like canoes, kayaks, and paddleboards are available locally). Grab lunch or a coffee in town, then stop by the Wells Gray Visitor Information Centre for maps, trail updates, and to book guided activities in the area.
